Scholarships and Awards Provided to Students

Recognition of talent in academics and sports amongst students is an essential part of developmental process. Scholarships based on excellence in academics and sports have been instituted to foster motivation, instil self confidence, sense of responsibility and competitiveness.

Students achieving excellence in academics but hailing from economically and socially weaker sections of the society are given scholarship to provide them financial help for attaining quality education.

Various scholarship schemes of

Government, Universities and private institutions are also available from time to time and granted to eligible students. Awards for ensuring and motivating students to be regular in attending classes has taken learning to a greater height while discouraging the tendency of students to take private tuitions.

Details of scholarships/ awards given to students and their eligibility criteria are given in the subsequent paras, the criteria of award may be changed from time to time, hence students are advised to see the relevant portals for latest updates.

Government Scholarships

Central Government Scholarship for Handicapped Students.

Handicapped regular college students having over 40% disability who are Indian nationals and not in receipt of aid from any other government scheme with family income from all sources less than Rs 3.0 Lakhs can apply online on government portal

Scholarship for SC/ST, OBC and Merit cum Means Scholarship for Minority Community Students.

Regular students of odd semesters (I, III, V and VII semesters) belonging to SC, ST, OBC Categories, can submit their application form online on

<http://www.scholarshipportal.mp.nic.in>

and students from Minority Community can submit on

<http://www.scholarships.gov.in>. Students

who have been admitted through NRI/CPQ/ IPQ are not eligible to apply. Having

submitted the application form online, students are required to submit all

mandatory certificates or proofs in the college by the next day. The applicant

must have over 75% attendance for the application to be accepted. Incomplete/

incorrect documents will render the application null and void. Eligible

students can apply for only one scholarship from either State or Centre or

private. Scholarship is admissible to students who are domicile of Madhya

Pradesh and come under the category as notified by Madhya Pradesh Government.

Students whose father/ guardian have income exceeding under mentioned

amount are not eligible:-

(a) SC	-	Rs. 3 Lakhs
(b) ST	-	Rs. 6 Lakhs
(c) OBC	-	Rs. 75 Thousand
(c) Minority	-	Rs. 2.5 Lakhs

Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students.

This central sector scheme provides

financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families to meet a part of their day to day expenses while pursuing higher studies. It has been introduced by The Department of Higher Education. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of results of Senior Secondary Examination. 82,000 (41,000 each for boys and girls) fresh scholarships will be allotted annually for

graduate/ post graduate studies in colleges and universities and professional courses. Total number of scholarship will be divided amongst State Boards on the basis of State's population in the age group of 18-25 yrs, after segregating share of CBSE and ICSE. State Board scholarships would be distributed amongst pass outs of the Science, Commerce and Humanities streams in the ratio of 3:2:1. Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream for a particular Board of Examination, in class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent, and not belonging to the creamy layer as defined by the Dept. of Personnel and Training in their notification issued from time to time, pursuing regular courses from recognized educational institutions and not availing any other scholarship scheme would be eligible. This is applicable to all categories of students both 'general' and 'reserved'. Students belonging to reserved categories/ weaker sections/ minorities are eligible on the basis of merit, subject to Central Reservation Policy and internal earmarking. Scholarship is renewable from year to year upto Post Graduation level in the same stream and till graduation level for professional courses. It can be renewed up to a maximum of five years. Renewal depends on promotion to next class with 60% or more marks or equivalent in Grade Point Average in aggregate for the two preceding semesters, maintenance of 75% attendance, discipline and not involved in ragging. There are provisions for renewal of scholarship, if scholar has not appeared in exams on medical grounds, medical certificate and Head of

Institution's certificate that the student would have scored more than 60% or equivalent grade had he appeared in the exams. The scholarship carries Rs 1000/- per month for first three years and Rs 2000/- for subsequent two years in which the duration of course is five years. The scholarship will be paid to students directly into a bank account opened by them. It will be paid for maximum 10 months in an academic year and will start from the month the admission is obtained. Short listing of students is done by the Scholarship Division of MHRD on the basis of applications received from students. Such students will be intimated by the Boards/ Universities/ Authority in the State/ UT.

- **Merit Cum Means Based Scholarship for Students Belonging to Minority Community**

The scholarship provides financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students belonging to minority communities to pursue technical and professional courses in India and will be awarded through State Government/ UT Administration or a designated agency (Central Government is considering awarding it directly and not involving State Government/UT, a Commission for which has recently been formed under Department of Minority Welfare, Government of India). Under this scheme 60,000 fresh scholarships will be allotted every year and their distribution will be done State/ UT wise based on the population of these communities in that State/UT. Accordingly MP has been allotted Muslim-1190, Christian-53, Sikh-47, Buddhist-65, Jain-169 scholarships. Financial assistance will be given to pursue graduate or post graduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution. Course Fee and Maintenance Allowance will be credited directly into bank account of selected students. Students who get admission on the basis of a competitive exam are eligible, however, those admitted without competitive exams are also eligible provided they have secured more than 50% marks in Higher Secondary level. Selection is done strictly on merit basis. Continuation of the scholarship in subsequent years

depends on successful completion of course in previous year. Scholarship holder will not avail any other scholarship/ stipend for pursuing the course. Annual income of family from all sources should not exceed Rs 2.5 Lakhs, the validity of income certificate is one year. State Deptt advertises the scheme every year and receives applications on line through the concerned institutions as per time lines. The State Government processes the application to Ministry. After scrutinizing, 30% scholarship is earmarked for girl students of each minority community. The scholarship amount is credited directly into bank account of selected students. It is dependent on satisfactory progress, conduct, correct statement in application, any violation can lead to cancellation, blacklisting, debarring and recovery of scholarship. It will be cancelled if there is any change in subject of the course or Institution without prior approval of State Govt. More details can be obtained from the website of the Ministry at www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. The rates of the scholarship are:

Maintenance Allowance for 10 months - Rs 1000/ per month for hostler and Rs 500/ per month for day scholar. Course Fee- Rs 20,000/ per annum or actual (whichever is less) for hostler and day scholar. Full course fee will be reimbursed for listed institutes.

- **Post-Matric Scholarship for Students Belonging to Minority Community.**

The scheme has been instituted to award meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community for better higher education opportunity. It is awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school/ college/ university as notified by the State Government. Scholarship is awarded to the students who have secured more than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final exam and the annual income of whose parents/ guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs 2.0 lakhs. The distribution of scholarship among States/ UT is made on the basis of population of minorities in the state/ UT. 30% of scholarship is

earmarked for girl students. Students from BPL families, having lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications will be fully exhausted before new applications are considered. Scholarship will be provided for complete course. Maintenance Allowance will be given for 10 months only in an academic year. Scholarship rates for admission and tuition fee for under graduate and post graduate courses is actual or up to a maximum of Rs 3000/ per year for hostler or day scholar. Maintenance Allowance of Rs 570/ and Rs 300/ for hostler and day scholar respectively is admissible for courses other than technical and professional at under graduate and post graduate level. The course fee/ tuition fee and Maintenance Allowance is credited directly to student's account. The award will be discontinued if student fails to secure 50% marks or equivalent grade in previous final exams or takes more than normal period of time. It will not be given to more than two students in a family. The student would need to have regular attendance as per yardstick decided by college/ university. Migration from one institute to another during academic year except under exceptional circumstances or giving false statement/ certificates could lead to discontinuation/ cancellation of scholarship. Student benefitting from this scheme is not allowed to avail benefits under any other schemes implemented by State Government for the same purpose. The scheme will be announced by concerned State Government through advertisement. More details can be obtained from www.scholarships.gov.in

- **Gaon Ki Beti Yojna**

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to motivate talented rural girls for higher education. Under this scheme, the MP State Government gives Rs 500/- and Rs 750/ per month scholarship for 10 months per year, respectively for traditional and technical education to the rural girls who pass their XII exams in first division and are admitted for higher education in government/ private college as a regular

student having tuition fee according to government fee structure. For details log on to <http://www.scholarshipportal.mp.nic.in>

- **Mukhya Mantri Medhavi Vidhyarthi Yojna**

This scholarship of Madhya Pradesh Government has been launched recently. Students who are residents of Madhya Pradesh, having father's/ guardian's income less than Rs 6 Lakhs and have scored 75% or more in MP Board or 85% or more in CBSE/ICSE exams of 12th class are eligible to apply. Additionally, students need to secure minimum rank of 50,000 in JEE (Mains) for seeking admission in engineering branch. Government will pay full fee if student is admitted in a government college and upto Rs 1.5 lakhs or actual fee amount, whichever is less, if admitted in a private college. In case the student is a beneficiary of any other Central/ State Government scholarship then the difference of amount will be granted. Families of beneficiary students will be required to return the money on completion of education. The scheme will come into effect from education session 2017-18. - **Pratibha Kiran Yojna**

This scholarship award is applicable to girl students who have completed 12th class in 1st Division from urban area and also reside in urban area, whose father's income is below poverty line and are admitted for higher education in government/ private college as a regular student having tuition fee according to government fee structure. Such students may be awarded Rs 750/- per month for 10 months every academic year.

- **Vikramaditya Yojna**

This award aims to provide free education at graduation and higher education level to below poverty line needy General Category students who have scored minimum 60% in 12th class and whose annual income of parents is below Rs 54,000/ and 1,20,000/ for graduation and higher education levels respectively.

AICTE Scholarships

Pragati (Scholarship for Girl Students).

It is aimed at providing assistance for advancement of Girls participation in technical education. There are 4000 scholarships. Amount of scholarship; Tuition Fee of Rs 30,000/- or at actual, whichever is less and Rs 2000/- per month for 10 months as incidentals each year. Only one girl per family can be given where annual income of the family is less than Rs 6 Lakhs. Selection of candidates is based on merit in qualifying exams to pursue technical education. Candidate should have been admitted to 1st year Degree or Diploma programme in any of the AICTE approved institutes through centralised admission process of the State/ Central Government. Reservation - 15% for SC, 7.5% for ST and 27% for OBC candidate/ applicant. Out of the total number of scholarship in each scheme, 50% are available at each Degree/ Diploma level. Saksham (Scholarship to Differently Abled Students)

It is aimed at providing encouragement and support to specially abled students to pursue technical education. There are 1000 scholarships. Amount of scholarship; Tuition Fee of Rs 30,000/- or at actual, whichever is less and Rs 2000/- per month for 10 months as incidentals each year, for specially abled students whose annual income of the family is less than Rs 6 Lakhs. Selection

of candidates is based on merit in qualifying exams to pursue technical education from among such candidates. Candidate should have been admitted to 1st year Degree or Diploma programme in any of the AICTE approved institutes through centralised admission process of the State/ Central Government. Reservation - 15% for SC, 7.5% for ST and 27% for OBC candidate/ applicant. Out of the total number of scholarship in each scheme, 50% are available at each Degree/ Diploma level. GATE/ GPAT Scholarship

Candidates qualified in GATE/ GPAT and admitted in engineering/ architecture/ pharmacy are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Candidates admitted for part time courses are not eligible. Admission before/ after GATE/ GPAT validity period are not eligible for the scholarship. Creamy layer OBC candidates who qualify under OBC category are not eligible for GATE scholarship. The GATE/ GPAT scholarships are given from date of commencement of classes/ date of admission (whichever is later) to completion of courses/ date of submission of thesis. It is disbursed for a maximum period of 24 months or till completion of courses/ date of submission of thesis, whichever is earlier. To achieve and promote girls' education, UGC has introduced a Post Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship for single girl child with an aim to compensate direct costs of girl education. The award is of Rs 2000/- per month for 02 years

and is applicable to girl child who is the only child or twin daughter or fraternal daughter in the family and has taken admission in regular, full time 1st yr Masters Degree course in any recognized college. ▪ **Anandam Vidya-Scholarship for Girls**

Aimed at addressing the education needs of girls from low income segment of society, the scheme provides financial assistance for professional courses like Engineering and Management. The scheme is circulated to different educational institutes, selected social organizations and social media for inviting applications. The applications, after verification, are forwarded by institutes where courses are to be pursued. The Executive Committee of Anandam can exempt/ modify the eligibility criteria for any special case. The Selection Committee screens the application and finalises them for award of scholarship after verification. Grant of scholarship is conveyed to Head of the Institute, where applicant will pursue her course, by President, Secretary/ Coordinator of Anandam. This process is followed every year at the start of academic session. The scheme is applicable to students from Indore District with preferably 70% marks in qualifying class/ exams for professional courses. Scholarship will be provided till completion of Degree/ Diploma courses subject to satisfactory performance in previous academic session. Scholarship amount will be limited to annual fees and is disbursed in two installments. Students coming from economically weaker sections with annual family income less than Rs 1.20 Lakhs from all sources or physically challenged or wards of Ex- Servicemen will be given preference. An undertaking by the parents is required that scholarship awardee shall not discontinue the course during midsession. Details can be obtained from <http://anandamvidya.org/>

Chairman's Scholarships/ Awards for Acropolis Students

Dr RM Sojatia Merit Scholarship
